To all GSS members reporting the death of their mother, father, sister, brother, children and spouses, and to all nonmembers reporting the death of a GSS member, please call 504-244-6800. If an extended family member of yours has transitioned, your information will be forwarded to the Intercessory Prayer Ministry. Under-staffing has been a great post-pandemic challenge, so we pray that you will lend us your patience. Our team of volunteers go The Extra Mile to serve families, and are often managing multiple Home Going Services simultaneously. Moreover, PRAY! ...the Lord will send skilled laborers to partner and assist in this area.

We will continue to evaluate the details of each homegoing celebration and determine scheduling according to our staff/personnel and the family's needs. Please note, there have been and may be times when our facility will be leased to host funerals or services which require a spacious edifice, as well as times when pastors whose buildings are inoperative may lease our building under the church policy regulation.

Finally, after prayerful/careful consideration, in order to properly repurpose our staff, we are temporarily unable to offer Morton Hall to you for rental. This includes, but is not limited to: repasts, memorials, birthdays or any other celebrations or gatherings.

In closing, we are grateful for your continued support of the ministry. Be assured that we are committed to serve this area with excellence and compassion, when the need arises.
