HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

In the 1940's, a small group of ladies met once a month on Sunday afternoons to plan mission activities. It was under the inspiration and directions of Emma Addison. In 1956, the Mission Society was reorganized and restructured. Leah L. Harrell served as the first president. Study meetings were held weekly on Wednesday nights. The church's Mission Offering was distributed by the Mission Society for financial assistance to their members, needed supplies, and outreach projects. Fifth Sunday nights were Mission Program Nights. In 1960, Thanksgiving baskets were distributed. Distributions continues through the present time. In 1963, the Holy Week Symposium was started 6 - 7am, Monday-Friday. In 1969, Sunday Morning was added, and in 1997, a three day Symposium. In 1975, the Food and Clothes Bin was established to assist the needy by the second president, Missionary Ella Mae Talbert.
