## WHAT ARE WE VOTING FOR?

On March 25, several parishes throughout the state will be conducting their regularly-scheduled elections for municipal offices (such as mayor, chief of police, councilman, etc.)

Some parishes will also have propositions to be considered and voted on (such as taxes, mills, bonds, amendments to city charter, etc.)

Additionally, some parishes, municipalities, and multi-parish districts will hold special elections to fill offices that are vacant due to the death or resignation of an incumbent, or due to a previous election being cancelled for lack of candidates.

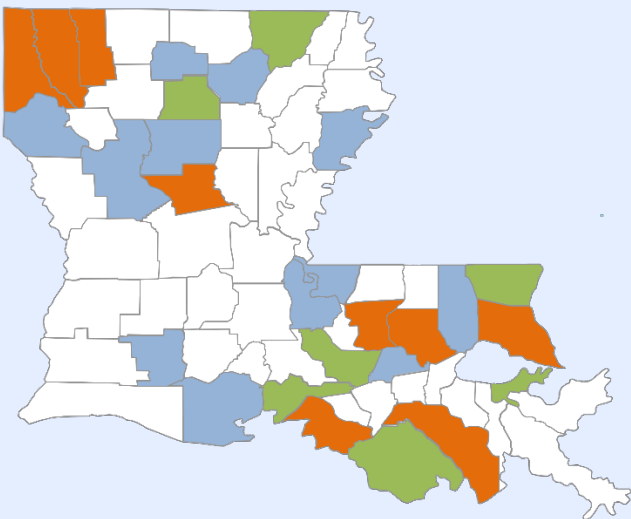

### LOUISIANA AT A GLANCE

- **7 parishes will have local races only on the ballot:** Iberia, Iberville, Jackson, Morehouse, Orleans, Terrebonne, and Washington.
- **12 parishes will have local propositions only on the ballot:** Ascension, DeSoto, Jefferson Davis, Lincoln, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Pointe Coupee, Tangipahoa, Tensas, Vermilion, West Feliciana, and Winn.
- **9 parishes will have both local races and local propositions on the ballot:** Bossier, Caddo, East Baton Rouge, Grant, Lafourche, Livingston, St. Mary, St. Tammany, and Webster.
- **36 parishes will have no elections:** Acadia, Allen, Assumption, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Bienville, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, East Carroll, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Franklin, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lasalle, Madison, Plaquemines, Rapides, Red River, Richland, Sabine, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. Helena, St. James, St. John, St. Landry, St. Martin, Union, Vernon, West Baton Rouge, and West Carroll.
